
**Publicity:** by Kerry AA9SB, at the October 2, meeting the program will be Steve Cooper "Those Wacky Game Shows."

#### **Power Distributor**


I needed a way to distribute 12VDC power to multiple radios and other devices throughout my shack.

MFJ makes devices to do this but tend to be expensive and I have heard the Power Pole connectors tend to not work well over 10A.



I found this item on Amazon for \$42. I am a Prime member so shipping was free. It's made by Blue Sea Systems for boats. Since boats run on 12VDC it's a perfect Ham application. Each tap can handle 30A and the block as a whole can handle 100A. It uses standard automotive ATO type fuses.

Not having the quick disconnects seems to be the only downside this product.





#### **Editor's Rambles**

#### **Liquid Metal Antenna**

All hams know the importance of antenna length and shape for determining operating frequencies and radiation patterns. We all diligently learned the dipole length formula for our license test. It's Length in feet =468/frequency just in case anyone forgot. Image how easy it would be if there were an antenna made of liquid metal able to change lengths on command. That's just what some North Carolina researchers have found.

There are some metal alloys such as a mixture of gallium and indium which are liquid at room temperature. The researchers have combined this metal with an electrolyte which changes the surface tension of the metal depending on if it exposed to a positive or negative voltage. A positive voltage lowers the surface tension allowing the metal to expand in a capillary tube and a negative voltage increases the surface tension causing the metal to retract in the capillary tube. There is no need for an external pump to move the metal meaning the size of the antenna can remain small making it perfect for wireless systems.

Current phones need reception for 4G, Wi-Fi and GPS. Imagine how useful a liquid antenna tunable to multiple frequencies could be inside your next smart device. For another use, think of those antenna farms on top of ships. I'm sure all of you on the SS Badger trips noticed the multiple antennas on the ships mast. A liquid metal antenna capable of changing lengths might just make the top of a ship look a little less crowded.




#### **Hamfesters VE Testing Report for October 2015**

#### <u>Upgrade Examinations:</u>

If you are already licensed and are taking an upgrade examination: Please bring your printed *original* license, and a copy of your current license that we can keep. Also, If you have recently taken an examination that has not been processed by the FCC, Please bring your *latest CSCE* and a *Copy of that CSCE* that we can keep. Retaking the Exam:

If you almost passed an exam on your first try, and would like to try again, you may retake a different version of the exam for an additional \$15 fee.

#### Morse Code Not Required!

Morse Code is no longer required for any level of amateur radio license. All Morse Code testing requirements for the Amateur Radio Service in the USA were eliminated on February 23, 2007.

Oak Forest City Hall 15440 S. Central Ave. Oak Forest, II 60452. Doors open at 9:00 AM. We begin testing about 9:15 AM. Enter through the Police door entrance and look for the Amateur Radio testing exam signs for directions.
