

Getting Your FRN (FCC Registration Number)

To conduct business with the FCC, you must register through FCC **CO**mmission **RE**gistration **S**ystem (CORES) and be assigned an **FCC Registration Number (FRN)**. This number will be used to uniquely identify you in all transactions with the FCC.

Anyone conducting business with the FCC must be registered in FCC CORES (COmmission REgistration System) and be issued an FCC Registration Number (FRN) before you can use ULS to renew your license, change your address, obtain a duplicate license, or use any of the other services that the FCC offers.

Register in **CORES** (**CO**mmission **RE**gistration **S**ystem) and receive your **FRN** (FCC Registration Number) before sitting for your exam to ensure your new license is processed quickly and easily through the FCC's ULS (Universal Licensing System). To conduct business with the FCC, you must register through FCC CORES and be assigned an FRN. This number will be used to uniquely identify you in all transactions with the FCC.


